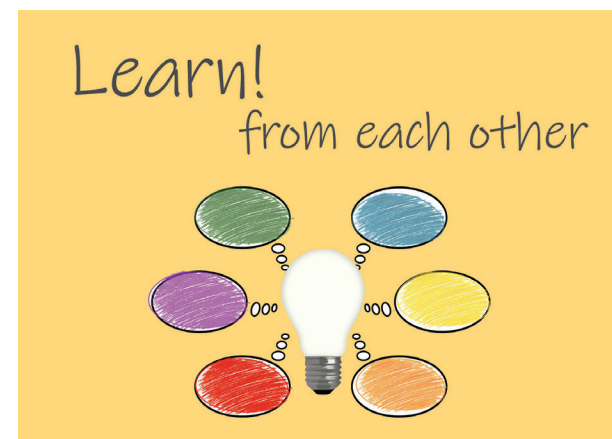

We are looking for people with creative ideas who want to share their talents with others and who want to learn from others’ talents. In this leaflet you can learn how to participate.

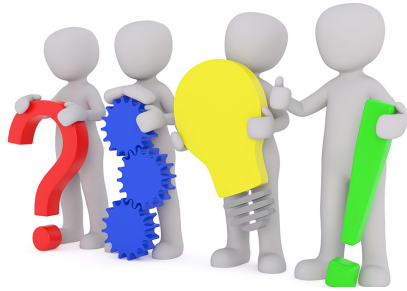
Everybody’s got talent – find out what you can learn!
